The model differentiates between aesthetic emotion and aesthetic judgments as two types of output.

the development of aesthetic experience that an aesthetic judgment of taste has four features: disinterest, universality, necessity, and purposiveness without a purpose.⁶ The pleasure one feels, by experiencing an aesthetic judgment of taste, is a pleasure of disinterest in which it is not based on the desire of one's having the need or want towards the object of art.
