Because its institutional structure and decision-making procedures are so complex, it cannot be readily be assigned to any one specific category of international organisation.

The European Union - A Brief History

the development of european gas markets environmental economic and political perspectives In 1950 the French Foreign Minister Robert Schuman proposed integrating the coal and steel industries of Western Europe, which led to the European Coal and Steel Community in 1951 – the predecessor of today’s European Union (see next chapter about his proposal in detail).

The original aim was to tie countries together by forging closer industrial and economic cooperation.
