the development of neolithic house societies in orkney Archaeological excavations at Göbekli Tepe, a transitional Neolithic site in southeast Turkey, have revealed the earliest megalithic ritual architecture with characteristic T-shaped pillars. Although human burials are still absent from the site, a number of fragmented human bones have been recovered from fill deposits of buildings and from adjacent areas.

the development of neolithic house societies in orkney Prehistory: Three stages .  
Prehistory is the period that begins with the appearance of the human being, about five

million years ago, and finishes with the invention of writing, about 6,000 years ago.; It is a long period divided into three stages: the Palaeolithic Age, the Neolithic Age and the Metal Age.; The Palaeolithic Age began with our first ancestors and finished about 10,000 years ago.
